Reminder: The Altruism year begins March 1st and ends February 28th/29th.

Some examples to consider:

Hours: volunteering at hospitals, food banks, nursing homes
transportation to doctors, shopping, running errands for someone
participating in a fundraiser for a charitable organization
tutoring, volunteering in schools
time spent planning for chapter meetings, doing reports for meetings
or chapter fundraisers

\$ donated: Money given in the name of Alpha Delta Kappa to a charitable organization or event.

\$ Value of Non-Monetary Gifts: The amount that items cost when given the name of Alpha Delta Kappa such as the items you bring to be given to teachers, shelters, etc.

We know it is hard to distinguish what is in the name of Alpha Delta Kappa. For example, if you go with a group from your church to help at a soup kitchen, then you would be volunteering for your church.
